For this course, you will obtain an internship and be a part of our community of MSU English interns in order to share experiences and learn from each other. In addition, your internship will teach you practical and technical skills that you can utilize in the work place and will help you make professional connections that can guide you into your future career.

Course Description:

Three hours lecture. Supervised work experience and realistic job training of at least 120 hours in related English Studies areas over at least eight weeks during the semester and roughly 30 hours of reflective coursework during the entire semester; evaluation by both instructor and job supervisor in order to receive three credit hours for the internship. **Prerequisites: Junior Standing & Consent of Instructor.**

Course Objectives:

As a result of taking this course, students will be able to:

- Explore potential career opportunities,
- Build professional relationships,
- Reflect on their experiences and assess their performances during internship,
- Communicate with and support classmates via assignments, and
- Communicate with supervisor and instructor regarding internship.
